History of the cinema in Wadowice

1915 – today

From movie theater to the “Centrum” Cinema

In 1915, Teofil Wysogład establishes a movie theater at Lwowska 16, which becomes the first place citizens of Wadowice can encounter the Tenth Muse. In the beginning of the 50s, the movie theater changed its name into “Szarotka” and was operating continuously until early 2003. On the 26<sup>th</sup> of September 2003, the “Centrum” Cinema came into life in the building of the local community center.

History of the cinema

For over 100 years already, people are able to watch the best movies on the cinema screen in Wadowice

### **1915**

Teofil Wysogład establishes the movie theater at Lwowska 16

### **1945 – 1950**

After Poland regained freedom, the movie theater changes its name to “Gdynia”

### **1950 – 2003**

The movie theater changes its name to “Szarotka”

### **2003 – until today**

The “Centrum” Cinema is established as a part of the Cultural Center

### **2010**

The cinema receives modern digital equipment which makes screening movie in 3D possible

## **Digital cinema**

Apart from the traditional, analog equipment used to screen films from a 35 millimeter film tape, modern, digital playback equipment has been installed in our cinema alongside a cinema server and a 3D attachment, known as DIGITAL CINEMA.

The cinema has also received professional SAT/TV equipment used to broadcast. It is used to, among others, broadcast operas from The Metropolitan Opera of New York and ballets from the Bolshoi Theater of Moscow.

## **Virtual walk around the cinema**

## + Cinema regulations

Cinema "Centrum" is situated in the building of Wadowickie Centrum Kultury - WCK (Eng. Wadowice Cultural Center) at Teatralna 1 in Wadowice. It is located in the show room of WCK.

The show tickets can be purchased in the cinema's box office, open before every show, in the center's office from Monday to Friday or anytime on the cinema's website by clicking the hour of the chosen show or in the "Kup bilet" tab.

### **Rules of the Cinema "CENTRUM"**

The list defines the rules of attending the cinema "CENTRUM" in the Wadowice Cultural Center. Their purpose is to provide reliable and quick assistance as well as to allow for an enjoyable and safe experience at our facility.

#### **GENERAL PROVISIONS:**

- Entering the screening room is possible only with a valid ticket
- By purchasing a ticket, you agree with the following regulations
- Tickets are valid only for a particular show, on the specified day and hour
- Tickets should be kept for a potential recheck during the entirety of the show it has been purchased for
- Staff members are allowed to ask clients without a valid ticket to leave
- You should only sit in the seat specified on your ticket
- Selection of the seat is only possible during pre-sale. Right before the show seats are sold in a random order.
- Staff members have the right to not allow a client who does not meet the age requirements of the upcoming show into the screening room, unless they are accompanied by a legal guardian
- During the film projection the following are prohibited:
  - Image and sound registration. Such practices are illegal and will be reported to the police
  - Use of phones during the projection
  - Drinking alcohol, smoking
  - Loud behavior that distracts others from the show
- Clients clearly under the influence of alcohol or drugs or who carry dangerous items will not be allowed on the property according to the Polish act of protection of people and property
- The cinema does not take responsibility for any items left in the screening room
- After the show, we ask to please leave the show room clean and tidy
- Any intentional damage will be reported to the police

#### **DETAILED PROVISIONS:**

1. To get information on the movie shows and a way to book the ticket, ask at the box office or call 33 82 33 957, 604072373
2. The box office opens one hour before the first show of the day and closes 15 minutes after the last show starts. Additionally, tickets can be purchased in the office of Wadowice Cultural Center (1<sup>st</sup> floor) on:
  - Monday: 8:00 – 20:00
  - Tuesday: 8:00 – 16:00
  - Wednesday: 8:00 – 20:00
  - Thursday: 8:00 – 16:00
  - Friday: 8:00 – 20:00

Saturday: from 1 hour before the first planned show of the day

Sundays: from 1 hour before the first planned show of the day

3. Tickets cannot be refunded

4. The box office is closed 15 minutes after the last show of the day starts

5. Group tickets are available for groups of at least 15 people and may only be bought at least 30 minutes before the show

6. The reduced price ticket is available for studying children up to 26 years old as well as for pensioners after showing a valid Pensioner ID to a staff member at the box office or by the entrance to the screening room. The reduced price ticket is also available for a handicap nurse

7. The family ticket is available for a parent(s) or a legal guardian(s) and at least two children on shows with age rating not higher than 15 years old

8. The pensioner, student or college student IDs alongside an Identification Document with a photo are checked at the box office during the purchase of the tickets or by the entrance to the screening room

9. The cashier may refuse to sell a ticket in special cases listed below:

1. If a client is not sober, is clearly under the influence of drugs, carries dangerous items or is a safety hazard to other clients.

2. If a client does not meet the age requirements of the show, unless they are accompanied by a legal guardian.

10. During the projection of 3D content, glasses compatible with the current 3D system installed in the cinema "CENTRUM" (i.e., Volfoni Creative 3D Technology) should be put on – compatible glasses: passive/clip-on glasses (circular polarization)

11. The glasses can be purchased at the box office and after the purchase they become the client's property. The glasses are reusable.

12. Clients have the ability to use their own 3D glasses, provided they're compatible with the system used in the "CENTRUM" cinema.

13. Individuals with visual impairments may have difficulty viewing 3D projections properly. In such cases, the cinema is not responsible for the quality of the projection and potential damage to eyesight.

14. The cinema is not responsible if a client buys a tickets for a 3D projection and does not use 3D glasses. This means that by doing this, the client is not entitled to a refund on the basis of the image's quality.

#### **FINAL PROVISIONS:**

- Smoking is prohibited in all areas of WCK.
- The restrooms are for the WCK clients only.
- The interpretation of these regulations is up to the Director of the Wadowice Cultural Center and to the manager of the "CENTRUM" cinema.
- These regulations are in effect starting from January 1 2014

## + Online ticket sale regulations

Before purchasing a ticket online please read the Terms and Conditions, available also on our website [www.wck.wadowice.pl](http://www.wck.wadowice.pl), and make sure you accept them.

### §1 Definitions

**WCK** – Wadowickie Centrum Kultury (Eng. Wadowice Cultural Center) of Marcin Wadowita, Teatralna 1, 34-100 Wadowice, REGON identification number 357232610, NIP (taxpayer identification number) 551-22-59-991, providing the Website.

**Buyer** – natural person or legal entity in possession of an online banking account who buys a WCK ticket online

**Regulations** – this document is the list of rules for WCK tickets sale online, specifies the terms, scope and conditions of using the Website

**Ticket Price** – the price of a ticket purchased by a client, consistent with the current price list and including VAT calculated in accordance with current regulations

**SMS Charge** – charge added to the Ticket Price purchased via the Website and sent via an SMS

**Transaction Price** – Ticket Price with the optional SMS Charge

**Payment Operator** – transferuj.pl Settlement Center which handles the transaction settlements for WCK tickets purchased by the Buyer via the Website using a credit card or an online transfer

### §2 General information

1. The Regulations specify the terms, scope and conditions of using the Website by the Buyer, the terms of refunding the Ticket Price purchased via the Website and the terms of filing a complaint
2. The Buyer is obliged to use the Website in a manner that does not violate the current law, social and customary norms and the provisions of the Regulations
3. The Buyer can choose a ticket from:
  - a) Ticket for persons with a Certificate, i.e., Ticket for persons who have been issued a certificate of vaccination against COVID-19 with a vaccine that has been approved for use in the European Union, subject to voluntary presentation and verification during the entry to the Event Area
  - b) Ticket for persons without a Certificate, i.e., Ticket for persons who do not meet the condition specified in point a); the number of these tickets is limited by law enacted by state authorities in regard to the COVID-19 pandemic.
4. §2 point 3 applies to specific events organized by Wadowice Cultural Center

### §3 Terms of tickets purchase via the Website

1. Ticket sale via the Website ends at 23:59 on the day before the date of the event, subject to §3 point 2
2. Ticket sale for movie shows via the Website ends 60 minutes before the time of the show
3. The agreement between the Buyer and WCK is concluded when all the following conditions are met:
  - a) the Buyer placed an order online, consistent with the form,
  - b) the Buyer paid the fee via an online bank transfer,
  - c) the Buyer received an email from WCK on the specified address containing relevant information and the ticket with a unique code
4. In the case of an additional choice of SMS as a preferred delivery method, this information and the purchased ticket will also be sent via SMS

5. The tickets remain the property of WCK until the access to funds necessary for paying the Transaction Price is confirmed by the Payment Operator
6. Use of the Website is possible when the following technical conditions are met:
  - a) In order to receive a ticket via SMS the Buyer is required to have a mobile phone with access to Internet and an ability to display QR Codes
  - b) To use a ticket sent via e-mail the following equipment is required: a computer with software capable of displaying PDF files and a printer with black ink and white paper
7. The Buyer is responsible for paying the cost of Internet connection to download a ticket sent via SMS or e-mail, according to their operator's pricing
8. WCK informs, that if the Buyer purchases any ticket with SMS delivery via the website, an SMS Charge is added

#### **§4 Terms of using the ticket**

1. Every ticket is labeled with a unique code and a corresponding transaction identification number (transaction ID) placed directly below it. The code is generated automatically and is shared only with the Buyer.
2. Depending on the chosen method of delivery, you should:
  - a) , directly at the entrance, present the ticket received via email – printed on a mobile device – and, in the case of a reduced ticket, a relevant document confirming the right to use the discount, or
  - b) , directly at the entrance, present the ticket received via SMS on your mobile phone and, in the case of a reduced ticket, a relevant document confirming the right to use the discount
3. Collection of the ticket from the box office is possible, at latest, 15 minutes before the start of the show (event, performance)
4. Before entering the show room, your ticket will be scanned, and in the case of purchasing a reduced ticket, relevant documents confirming the right to use the discount will be verified. On the occasion of the client not having a relevant document confirming the right to use the discount, they will not be allowed into the show room
5. Only the first person to present a ticket with a given code is allowed into the show room
6. The ticket should be kept in a safe place. Giving it to another person by the Buyer, copying, or losing the ticket, as well as sharing the ticket or the transaction ID to third parties may result in the Buyer not being allowed to partake in the show (event, performance) the ticket has been purchased for.
7. WCK is not obliged to issue a refund of the Ticket Price or any other compensation on the occasion an unauthorized person uses a ticket and enters the show room as a result of the situations described in point 6

#### **§5 Terms of refund of tickets purchased via the Website**

1. A ticket purchased via the Website does not entitle to a refund of the Ticket Price or to an exchange for a different ticket, except for the case of the cancellation of the show (event, performance).
2. On the occasion the show (event, performance) is cancelled due to WCK's fault, WCK will issue refunds.
3. To get a refund you should:
  - a) report to the box office, and
  - b) present the cashier with a transaction ID of the purchased ticket.
4. The money is refunded in the same form in which the tickets have been purchased.

## **§6 Terms of complaints**

1. Complaints referring to the service, including the malfunctioning of the Website, defects and errors in the received documents should be reported to WCK via email at [centrum@wck.wadowice.pl](mailto:centrum@wck.wadowice.pl) or mail to Marcin Wadowita Wadowice Cultural Center, Teatralna 1, 34-100 Wadowice.
2. The complaint submission should include:
  - a) the details of the Buyer, consistent with the ones stated in the transaction of the ticket via the Website
  - b) date of the ticket purchase and the ID of the transaction the complaint refers to
  - c) description of complaint subject
3. A correctly submitted complaint will be processed no later than within 7 working days counting from the moment the information about the error is received, and in specially complicated cases, not later than within 10 working days
4. Complaints related to payment should be reported to the Payment Operator according to the regulations found on the Payment Operator's website – [www.transferuj.pl](http://www.transferuj.pl)

## **§7 Data protection**

1. By accepting the terms of sale, the Buyer thereby agrees to have their personal data provided in the order form processed by WCK
2. All data provided by the Buyer is automatically encoded before transferring to WCK in a safe code and is processed confidentially
3. The personal data of the Buyer is used by WCK for administrative purposes, subject to legal safeguards and limitations under the law on the protection of personal data.
4. The Buyer has the right to request an erasure or amendment of their personal data at any time.

## **§8 Final provisions**

1. WCK is not responsible for the malfunctioning of the Internet network the Buyer uses
2. WCK is not responsible for the loss of messages, confirmations and other data in the Internet network, personal computer settings and their configurations, as well as settings and outages of services of the operator of the Internet network.
3. These Regulations are accessible at the WCK box office and on the website [www.wck.wadowice.pl](http://www.wck.wadowice.pl) in a form that can be downloaded, recorded or printed.
4. WCK can alter these Regulations at any time. The moment of publication of a new version of the Regulations on the website [www.wck.wadowice.pl](http://www.wck.wadowice.pl) is the moment they come into effect. Temporary provisions are utilized in regard to orders that have been placed before the publication of new Regulations, unless the Buyer agrees on paper to have the new Regulations apply to them.
5. In matters not regulated by the Regulations, the provisions of the Act on Providing Services by Electronic Means and of the Civil Code apply.

## + Independent cinemas

The activities of the Independent and Local Cinemas Network aims to disseminate film culture by means of, in particular, presenting films of high artistic value in the Network's cinemas and educating the cinemas' younger audiences. The Network's structure is made up of cinemas, which have committed to its program via contracts established with the Network's operator – Filмотeka Narodowa (Eng. 'national film archive'). In turn, the operator financially supports the cinemas and facilitates their access to the desirable – from the point of view of the Network – film repertoire. The Network Program is financed by the Polish Film Institute, the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage and the Filмотeka Narodowa. You can read more about the Network on its official website.
